## ANTI-DRUG & ANTI-NARCOTIC POLICY

### Purpose

The widespread use of narcotics within and outside educational institutions has emerged as a grave concern in contemporary times. Drug dealers specifically target students, exploiting them both as carriers and clients. It's imperative for teachers and parents to unite against this pervasive threat and strive to eradicate it from our educational environments. Recognizing the crucial role of education and awareness in guiding the highly energetic youth away from narcotics, we have established an anti-narcotic cell within our college. This initiative aims to foster a close partnership with law enforcement agencies, such as the excise and police departments, to emphasize the stringent legal measures in place against narcotics. Additionally, we endeavour to instil in students a deep respect for their parents, teachers, and the Indian judiciary through various educational programs.

In accordance with the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, which strictly prohibits various activities related to narcotics, SAL Education Campus is committed to maintaining a drug-free environment. We unequivocally forbid any actions that contravene this Act and have formulated the following policy to address drug trafficking and the use of illegal substances within our campus premises:

### Policy Resolution:

1. Establishment of Antinarcotics Committee:

An effective vigilance committee has been formed to spearhead the activities of the anti-narcotic cell and to conduct awareness campaigns against drug use on campus.

2. Enforcement of total ban:

A comprehensive ban is imposed on the possession, consumption, or use of drugs and alcohol by students, whether within or outside the campus premises.

### **Antinarcotics Committee Responsibilities:**

- Organizing Awareness Programs: Collaborating with government-authorized organizations to conduct awareness programs within the college premises.
- Educating Students: Providing education on the detrimental effects of drugs and alcohol to students.
- Promoting Peer Policing: Encouraging students to monitor and report any instances of drug use among their peers.
- Reporting Incidents: Ensuring prompt reporting of any observed drug use by students to the relevant authorities.

### **Procedure/Action:**

Upon receiving any report of the use, possession, or confiscation of narcotics within the campus, the Security team will promptly cordon off the area. A mobile video recording of the scene will be made, capturing the position of the items in question, along with any oral statements provided by the accused. The Anti-narcotic Committee will then take appropriate action, which may include notifying the local police for further investigation, based on the severity of the incident.

**Records:**

A comprehensive register documenting all offenses reported to the cell will be meticulously maintained on a yearly basis, detailing each event. In the event of no incidents occurring throughout the academic year, a statement indicating zero occurrences ("NIL") should be recorded in the register, accompanied by the signatures of at least two committee members.
